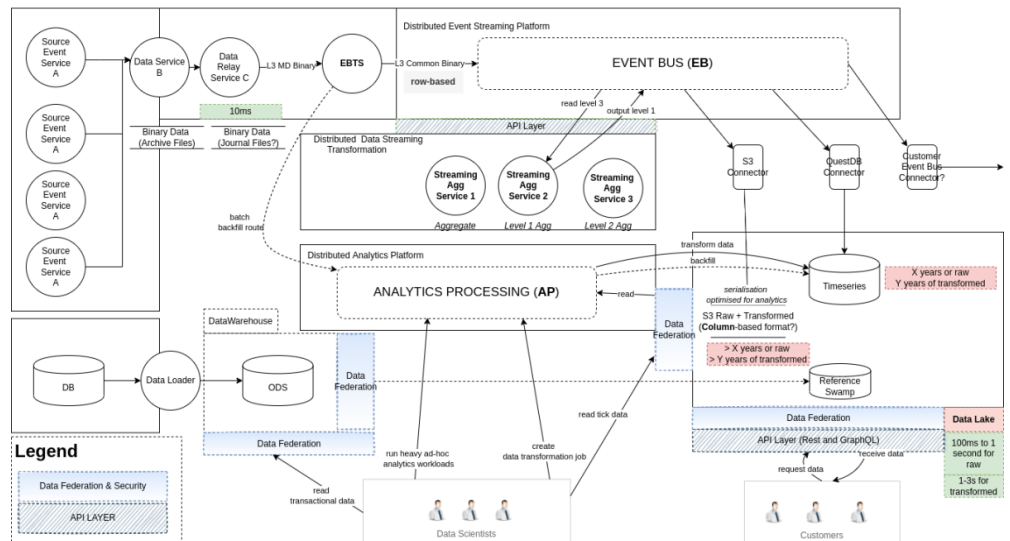

Big Data Streaming Platform Reference Architecture

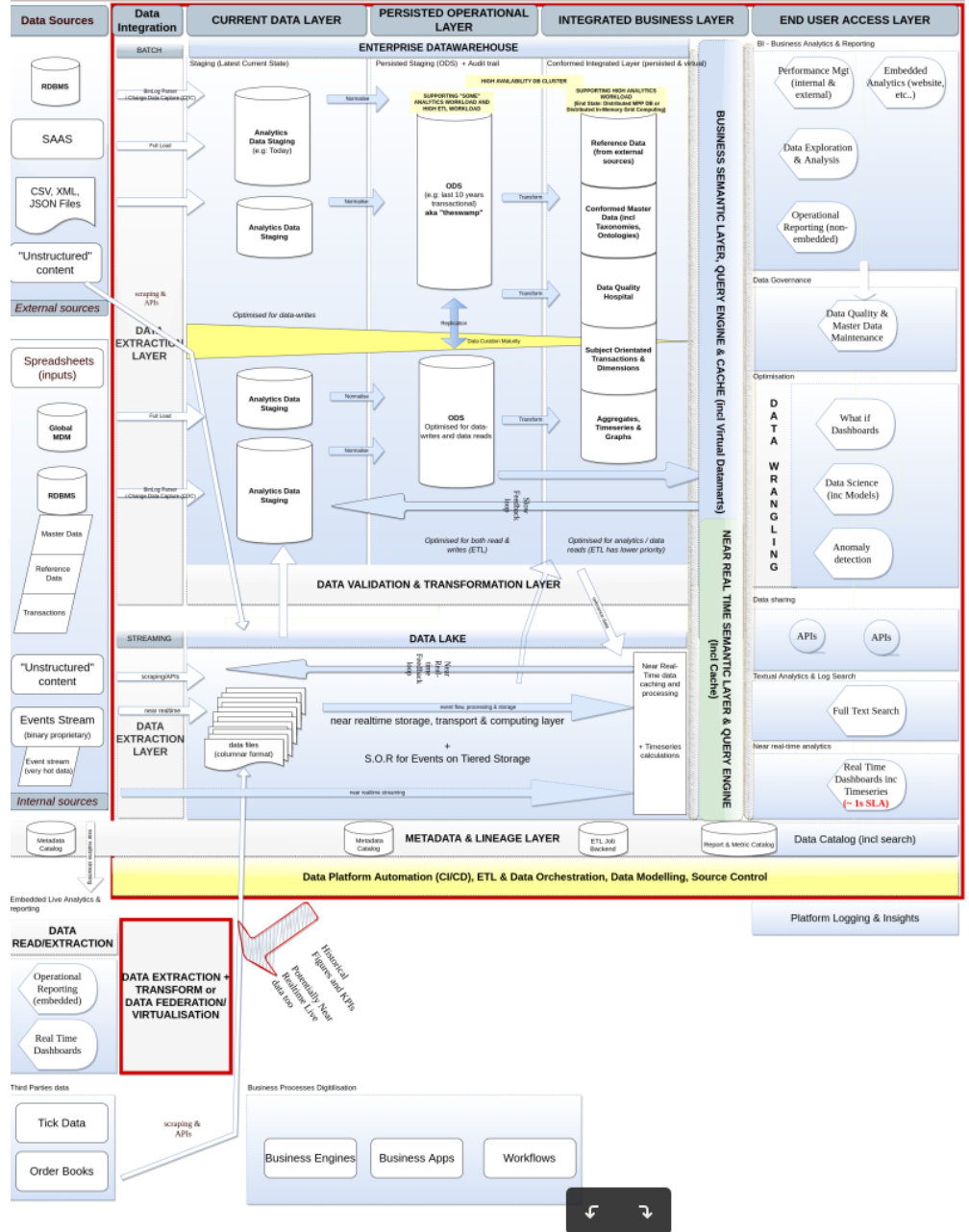
XXX Streaming Data Analytics Pipeline - Reference - Target TO BE

All,

We had the opportunity to view Fred Tremblay's Hack Day winning prototype app last week in London. In short it was extremely impressive and in my mind an example of how using existing resources, keeping it simple can deliver an incredibly useful tool to the field organization to make more placements.

It's use of existing systems and data combined with externally available web based resources such as google earth, LinkedIn and other social media highlights that we do not need to build hugely complex and expensive systems to provide workable solutions to the front line sales force.

I think this highlights an opportunity for us to re-examine how we gather and use sales data. Perhaps we should be thinking more deeply about how we leverage what we already have and what is available in the public domain? I am sure that I am over simplifying this?

At the very least I would encourage Alan, Lars, Christy, Nigel, Fred, Bob and Michelle to come together to discuss.

In 2009, Corporate Services hosted their first ever "IT Hack Day." The event offered our IT teams the opportunity to imagine and create innovations that could improve job functions or company systems. The results that first year included 60 registered ideas or "hacks" and participation from more than 300 employees who voted for their favorite entries.

"Due to the success of the 2009 IT Hack Day and the positive feedback we received from the event, we decided to invite all of our Corporate Services departments worldwide to participate in the 2010 event," said IT program manager Hack Day was going on tour.

The theme was "Hack Star 2010," and the event encouraged our internal employees to think outside the box, with no restrictions, of what they could invent if given the right resources. Thirty-seven hacks were registered from all departments across Corporate Services. Voting was online so that our teams around the world could cast a ballot. The top 15 hacks were then presented to an executive panel of judges, and, sticking to the rock-star theme, Platinum and Gold "record" winners were selected in multiple categories, including an Overall Hack Day Winner.

"What's so great about conducting an event like Hack Star is that you give people the time and opportunity to put together solutions for companywide issues without limitations," said senior director of Enterprise Shared Services who brought the initial concept of Hack Day from a similar event she conducted at a prior employer. "Innovation is what keeps us pushing forward as an organization, but also what helps us remain passionate about what we do."

The Platinum award recipients have since been sponsored by an executive judge and are working with approved budgets to possibly implement their ideas companywide.

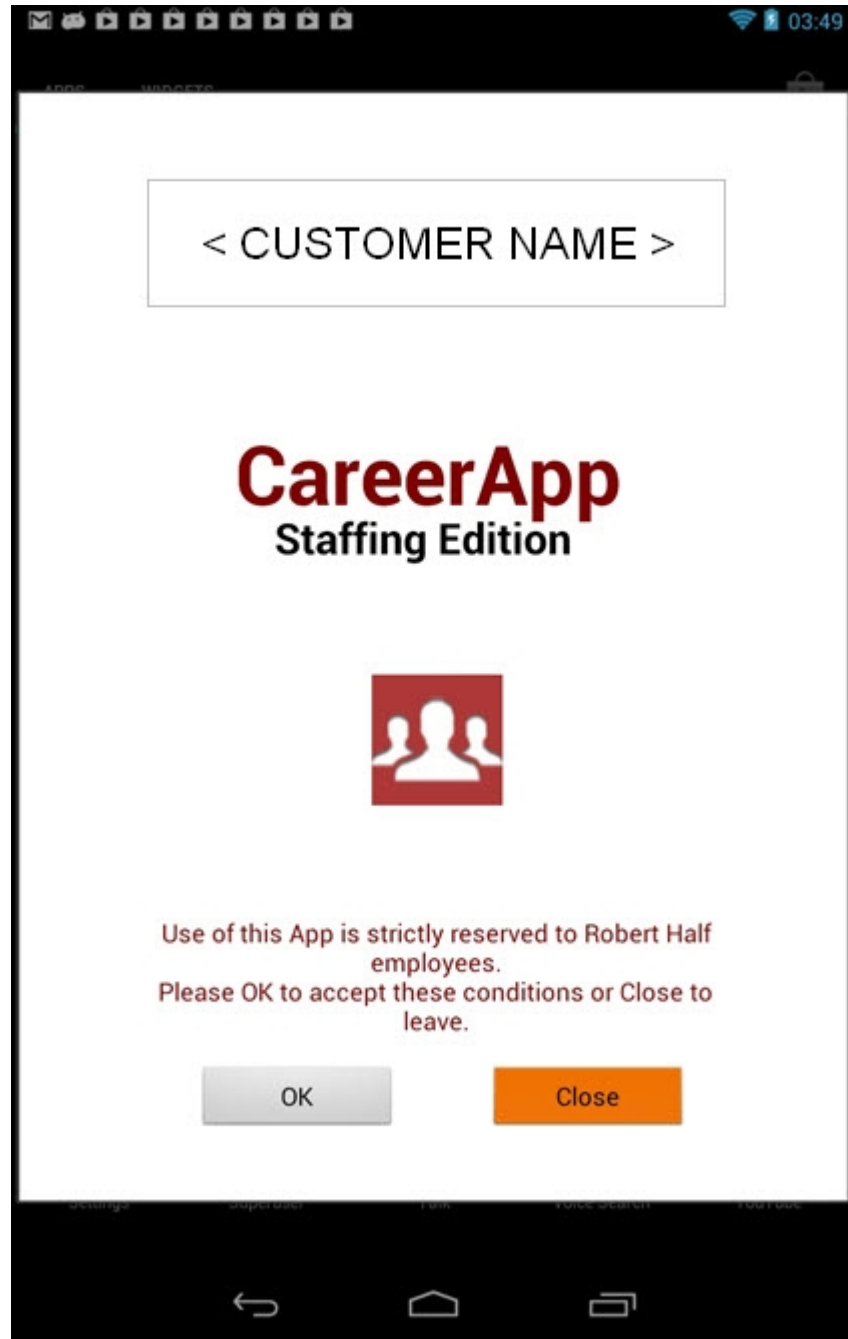

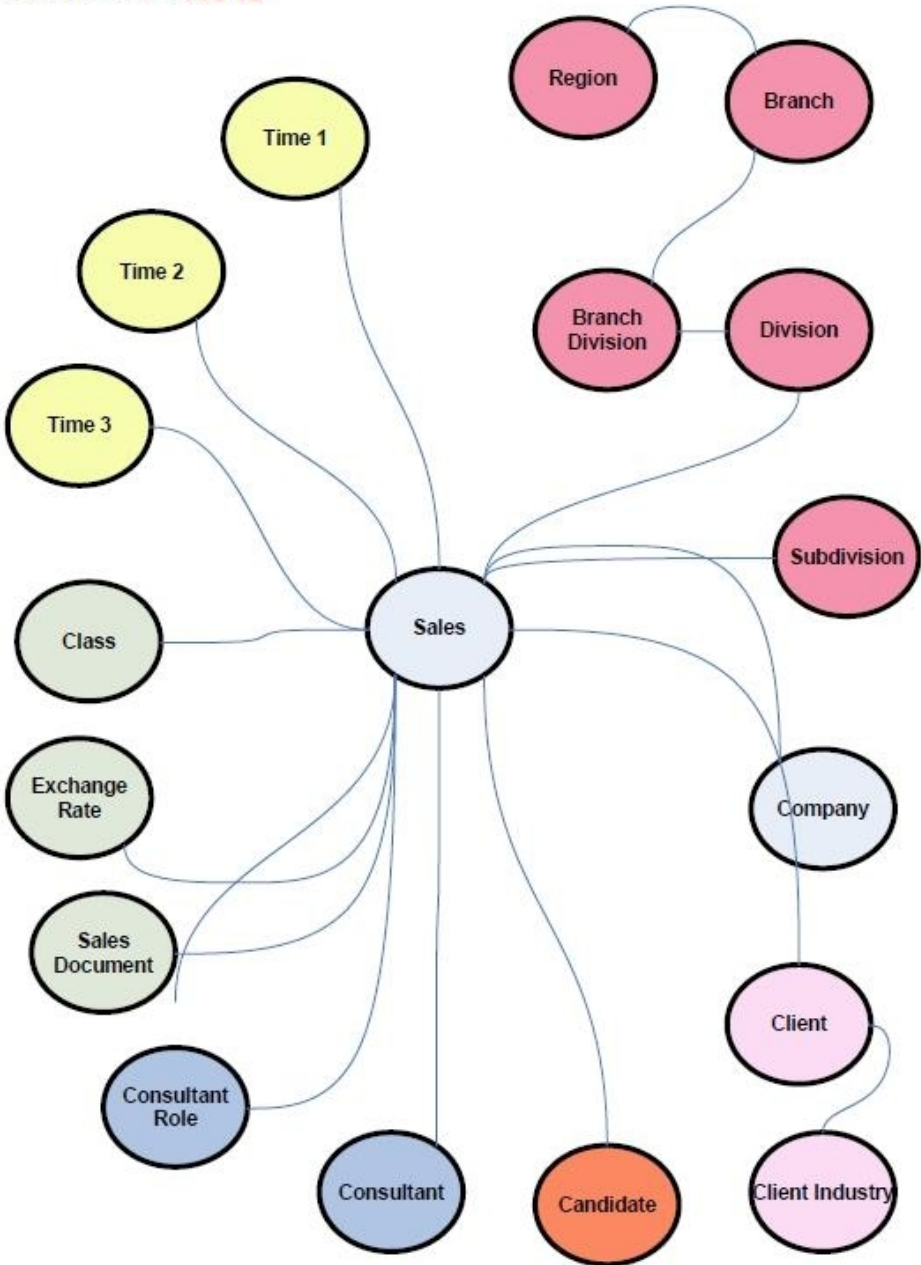

Model - BI Logical Model - Recruitment Enterprise DataWarehouse



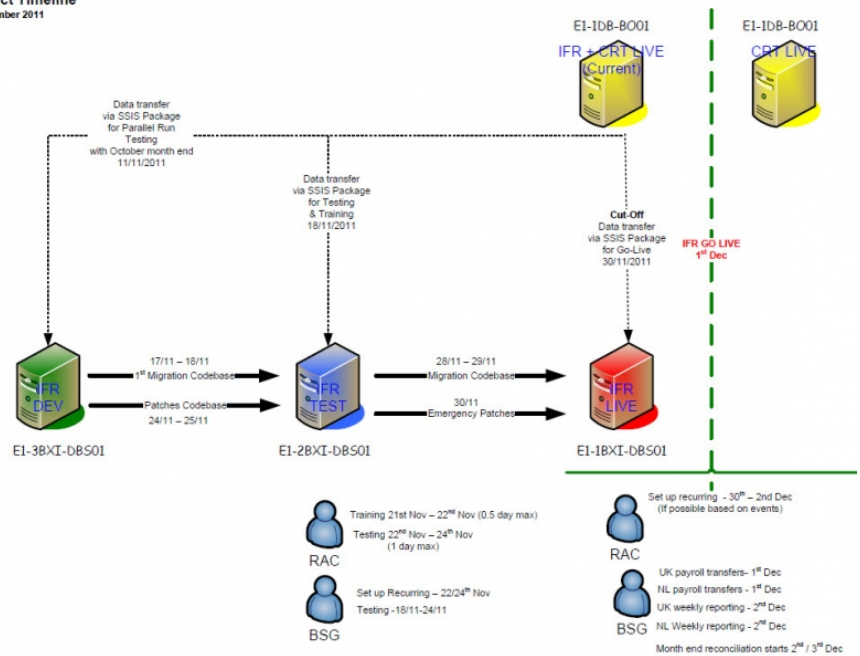
Model - BI Logical Model - Recruitment Snowflake Schema

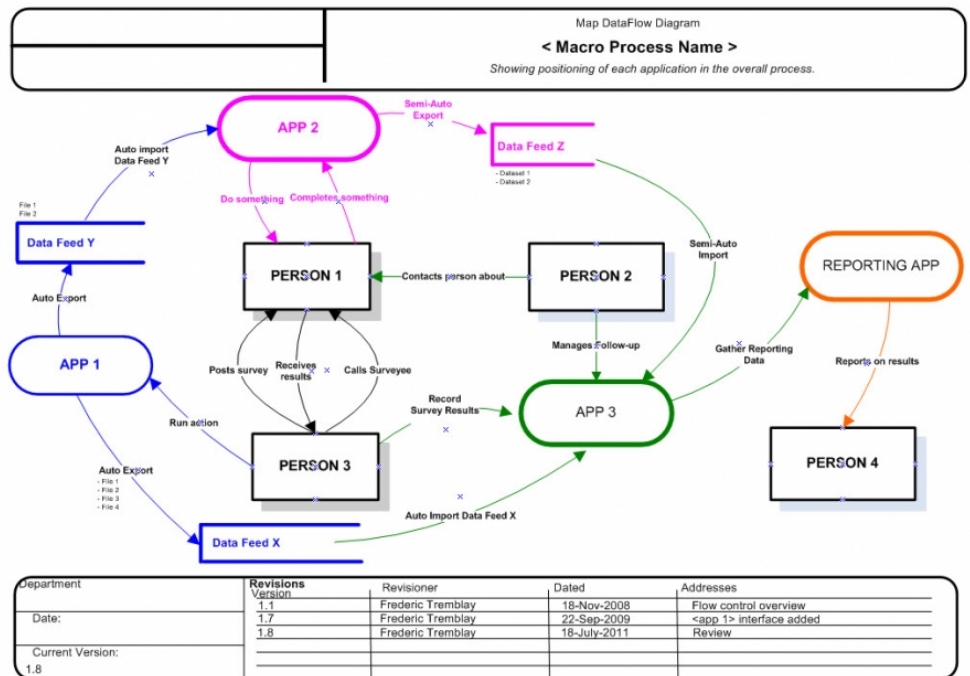
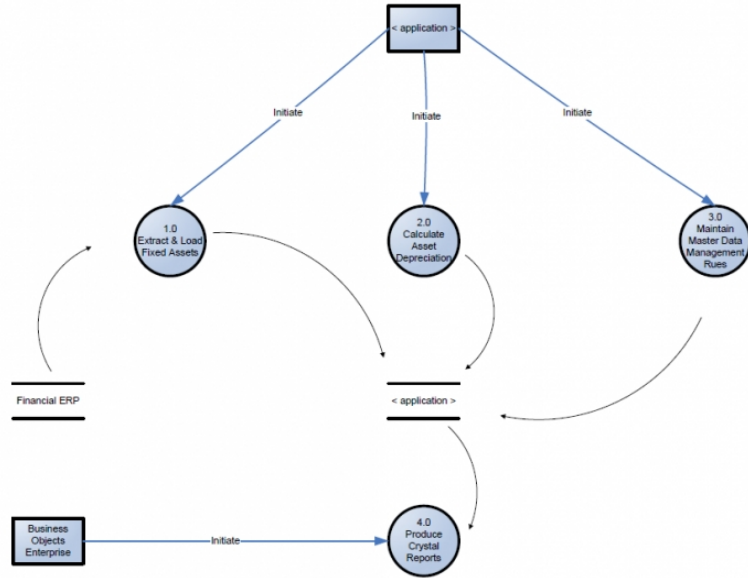


Diagram - DataFlow - Fixed Assets Gaap Reporting Application
